By Mr. MacLean, a petition of William Q. MacLean, Jr., for legislation to authorize the town of Fairhaven to enter into certain agreements relative to the supply of certain sewerage and sewer related services. Local Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FAIRHAVEN TO ENTER INTO CERTAIN AGREEMENTS RELATIVE TO THE SUPPLY OF CERTAIN SEWERAGE AND SEWER RELATED SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 to the contrary, the town of Fairhaven, through its board of select-
3 men, and the city of New Bedford, through its executive officer
4 and city council, are hereby authorized to enter into agreements
5 for the supply of sewer and sewer related services to a marina to
6 be built on Pope's Island in the city of New Bedford.

7 Said agreements may provide that such services shall be pro-
8 vided for a period of forty years or more and shall provide that
9 the town of Fairhaven shall be reimbursed for all costs related
10 to the provisions of such services, and shall be signed by the chief
11 executive officer of said town and city.
