

SENATE No. 1709

By Mr. Lewis, a petition of Arthur Joseph Lewis, Marie-Louise Kehoe and Gregory W. Sullivan for legislation to prohibit the construction of any privately owned buildings on certain land owned by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority. Transportation.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY PRIVATELY OWNED BUILDINGS ON CERTAIN LAND OWNED BY THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Land owned by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation
2 Authority, situated in the Towns of Dedham and Westwood, and
3 known as the Route 128 Railroad Station, located at the
4 University Avenue interchange with U.S. Interstate 95/State
5 Route 128, containing approximately 5.1 acres in the Town of
6 Dedham and approximately 3.0 acres in the Town of Westwood,
7 shall not be used for the construction of any buildings for the
8 benefit of any private corporation or other legal entity, either by
9 sale or lease, other than for transportation purposes.
