

SENATE No. 1721

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (m) of section three of chapter eight hundred eleven
2 of the acts and resolves of nineteen hundred and eighty-five is
3 hereby amended by adding after the word "value" the
4 following: —

5 " , or for the acquisition by eminent domain under the provisions
6 of chapter seventy-nine, or by purchase or otherwise of land or
7 rights in land to be used by the department as sole compensation
8 in the acquisition by agreement between the department and a
9 lawful title holder of land or rights in land which is of greater
10 acreage and appraised value and located within or adjacent to
11 public ways for the purpose of restoring, preserving or enhancing
12 areas of scenic beauty or special environmental value."
