1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Human Services and Elderly  
2 Affairs be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court  
3 to make an investigation and study of Senate document numbered  
4 666 relative to prisoner furloughs.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results  
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,  
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-  
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the  
9 Senate on or before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen  
10 hundred and eighty-nine.
