AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BARRE TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO PENN VALLEY CORPORATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter  
2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing  
3 authority of the town of Barre is hereby authorized to issue to  
4 Penn Valley Corporation d/b/a Penn Valley Country Store, a  
5 license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages, not to be drunk on  
6 the premises under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter  
7 one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to all  
8 the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except  
9 said section seventeen; provided, however, that the licensing  
10 authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other  
11 person, organization, corporation or location; and provided,  
12 further, that the granting of this license shall reduce by one any  
13 increase in licenses granted due to census reapportionment under  
14 section seventeen.
