AN ACT ENLARGING THE TERRITORY OF THE WARREN WATER DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 390 of the acts of 1920 is hereby amended
2 by striking out Section 1 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —

4 Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Warren who reside
5 within and are liable to taxation on real estate situated within the
6 territory comprised within the following boundary lines, to wit.
7 Starting at the intersection of the center line of the West
8 Brookfield Road, route 67, and the center line of Patrick Road;
9 we are thence running westerly to the intersection of the center
10 line of Coy Hill Road and the center line of Reynolds Road; thence
11 continuing westerly to the easterly boundary line of West Warren
12 Water District at a point in said easterly boundary line distant
13 1,000 feet northerly measured along said easterly boundary line
14 from the center line of Old West Warren Road; thence southerly
15 along said easterly boundary line to the center line of Route 67,
16 also called West Main Street; thence continuing southerly along
17 said easterly boundary line to the southerly side line of the Conrail
18 Railroad right of way; thence southeasterly to a point in the center
19 line of Reed Street distant 1,500 feet southerly from and measured
20 along said center line of Reed Street from its intersection with
21 the center line of Bridge Street; thence continuing southerly along
22 the same course to a center line of Brimfield Road, Rte. 19; thence
23 running easterly to a point in the center line of Bemis road at the

24 westerly corner of Lot 10 shown on a plan of Land recorded with
25 Worcester District Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 470, Plan 82;
26 thence southerly and easterly along said land shown in Plan Book
27 470, Plan 82 to the center line of Southbridge Street; thence
28 northerly to a point in the center line of East Street at the
29 southwesterly corner of land of Elizabeth Willis, distance
30 approximately 820 feet easterly from the intersection of East
31 Street and the northerly line of Washington Street; thence
32 northerly to the place of beginning, shall constitute a water
33 district, and are hereby made a body corporate by the name of
34 the Warren Water District, for the purpose of supplying
35 themselves with water for the extinguishment of fires and for
36 domestic and other purposes, for assessing and raising taxes for
37 payment of such services, and for defraying the necessary expenses
38 to carry on the business of said District.

39 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance within
40 one year at a meeting of the Warren Water District at which
41 persons constituting the Water District as herein established shall
42 be entitled to vote. Upon acceptance as provided herein the
43 redefined Warren Water District shall be the corporate successor
44 to the former Warren Water District and shall succeed to all
45 property, liabilities and contracts of the Warren Water District
46 as previously established.
