(House, No. 32). Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEE DISPUTE IMPASSE PROCEDURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 150E of the General Laws is amended by
2 striking paragraph 3 in section 9, and inserting in place thereof
3 the following: —

4 After a reasonable period of mediation from the date of ap-
5 pointment, said mediator shall issue to the board a report indi-
6 cating the results of his services in resolving the impasse.

1 SECTION 2. Section 150E of the General Laws is amended by
2 striking sentence 6 of paragraph 4 in Section 9, and inserting in
3 place thereof the following: —

4 The fact finder shall transmit his findings and any recommen-
5 dations for the resolution of the impasse to the board and to both
6 parties within thirty days after the record is closed.
