## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXAMINATIONS BY THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF COSMETOLOGY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 87KK of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appear-  
2 ing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking  
3 out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 paragraph: —

5 Every applicant for registration as a hairdresser, aesthetician,  
6 manicurist, instructor or operator shall receive notice from the  
7 board prior to the examination of the time and place of the  
8 examination. If the applicant does not appear for the  
9 examination, the examination fee, as provided for in section  
10 eighty-seven CC, shall be retained by the board, and thereafter  
11 such applicant shall register anew as provided in sections eighty-  
12 seven T to eighty-seven JJ inclusive.
