AN ACT CONCERNING REVENUES OF CHILD AND ADOLESCENT PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Massachusetts General Law Chapter 19, Section 16 is hereby
2 amended by deleting the last paragraph thereof and inserting in
3 its place the following: —

4 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all
5 revenues received by the community mental health facilities
6 operated by the department, or by child or adolescent mental
7 health programs operated or funded by the department, shall be
8 deposited in one or more trust funds in the state treasury of which
9 the commissioner shall be trustee and may be expended by the
10 department for the operation and maintenance of such
11 community mental health facilities, or such child or adolescent
12 mental health programs, as applicable, and may be further
13 expended for the management, stabilization and delivery of
14 mental health services by and through such community mental
15 health facilities, mental health programs and other affiliated
16 service providing agencies; provided, that all expenditures from
17 said trust funds so made shall conform to standard state
18 accounting procedures and such further requirements as
19 prescribed by the comptroller; provided further, that the
20 commissioner in his capacity as trustee shall report monthly to
21 the commissioner of administration and to the house and senate
22 committees on ways and means such revenues and reimburse-
23 ments received and expenditures made; and provided further, that
24 whenever any such trust fund ceases to be operative, all monies
25 remaining in such fund shall accrue to the General Fund.
