AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CLEAN AN OIL SPILL IN THE TOWN OF COHASSET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 199 of the acts of 1987 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after item 2120-1506 the following item:

2120-1510	For reimbursement to the town of Cohasset to clean an oil spill in the Aaron river to protect the water supply of said town	105,000.
