**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT TO INDEMNIFY MEMBERS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS FIRE ACADEMY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 41 of the Massachusetts General Laws as appearing  
2 in the 1986 Official Edition is amended in Section 100 by adding  
3 the following paragraph: —

4 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary any fire fighter  
5 of a uniformed member of a paid fire department, fire district  
6 or to any permanent crash crewman, crash boatman or fire  
7 controlman employed at the General Edward Lawrence Logan  
8 Airport, shall be covered by the provisions of this section when  
9 they are employed at the Massachusetts Fire Academy by the  
10 Department of Public Safety either as a part time employee or  
11 a consultant.
