AN ACT REQUIRING STATE DEPARTMENT TO NOTIFY MUNICIPALITIES OF CERTAIN ACTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 35A the following section: —
- 3 Section 35B. Any department which takes any action which
- 4 affects any ordinance or by-law of a city or town shall notify the
- 5 appropriate local department of such action.

The House of Representatives is the lower branch of the United States Congress. It is composed of members from each state and the District of Columbia. The House has the power to initiate revenue bills and to impeach federal officials.

The Constitution of the United States
