AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE OF ELIGIBILITY FOR REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTIONS TO AGE SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTIONS 1. Clause forty-one of section 5 of chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 1069 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out in the first sentence wherever appearing, the word
5 "seventy" and inserting in place thereof the word "sixty-five".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
