AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE EMPLOYMENT OF ADDITIONAL INSPECTORS
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING THE "RIGHT-OF-KNOW" LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of labor and industries is hereby authorized
2 to employ ten additional inspectors for the purpose of the
3 enforcement of the provisions of chapter four hundred and
4 seventy of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-three, the so-
5 called "Right to Know" law.
