AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CANCELLATION OF ACCIDENT AND SICKNESS INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 108E, inserted by section 2 of chapter 188 of the acts
- 3 of 1986, the following section: —
- 4 Section 108F. Every company which issues a policy of insurance
- 5 under the provisions of section one hundred and eight which may
- 6 be cancelled shall, forty-five days prior to the date of intended
- 7 cancellation, notify the insured that such policy will be cancelled
- 8 and the date thereof. If such company fails to so notify the insured,
- 9 such policy shall remain in effect until such notification.
