AN ACT RELATIVE TO MAKING THE EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS SERVING ALCOHOL AN ARRESTABLE OFFENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 34 of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 Any officer authorized to make arrests may arrest without a
- 4 warrant and keep in custody for not more than twenty-four hours,
- 5 unless Sunday intervenes, any person in violation of this section.
