## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT ALLOWING MEMBERS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SOUND INSULATION PROGRAMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 268A of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: —  
3 This section shall not prohibit a member of the Massachusetts  
4 Port Authority from participating in any residential sound  
5 insulation programs by said Authority.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 23 of chapter 465  
2 of the acts of 1956, as amended by chapter 328 of the acts of 1960,  
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "both", in  
4 line 7, the words: — ; provided, however, that a member of the  
5 Authority shall be eligible to participate in any residential sound  
6 insulation programs administered by said Authority.
