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AN ACT ALLOWING FOR THE DEDUCTION OF MEDICAL EXPENSES WHEN DETERMINING GROSS RECEIPTS FOR THE PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL PROGRAM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause 41A of section five of Chapter 59 of the General Laws,
- 2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
- 3 inserting in line 804 after the word "expenses", the following: —
- 4 provided, however, that medical expenses of an applicant and
- 5 his spouse may be deducted.
