AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO SOUND-
PROOF HOMES IN CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE CITIES OF BOSTON AND
REVERE AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby authorized and
2 directed to soundproof all homes in the vicinity of the General
3 Lawrence Logan International Airport in which the sound effects
4 from aircraft are above the number of decibels as determined by
5 the executive secretary of environmental affairs. The homes to be
6 soundproofed under the provisions of this act shall include but
7 not be limited to the homes in Point Shirley and Court Road sec-
8 tions of the town of Winthrop; the Jeffries Point section of East
9 Boston; and the Beachmont and Point of Pines sections of the
10 city of Revere.
