AN ACT RELATING TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding after the word "constable" the following: "or  
3 any investigator of the Alcoholic Beverages Control  
4 Commission . . .".
