RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES OF DPU.

1 *Resolved*, That there shall be a commission to study and
2 evaluate the adequacy of rates, established by department of
3 public utilities, paid small power generators and cogenerators.
4 Said commission shall have nine members; three of whom shall
5 be members of the house of representatives appointed by the
6 speaker of the house; three shall be members of the senate
7 appointed by the senate president; and three shall be appointed
8 by the governor, one being a representative of a utility which
9 purchases power from small power producers and cogenerators,
10 and one being a small power producer. The commission shall
11 make its report no later than twelve months after all appointments
12 have been made.
