AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROOF OF AGE OF CONSUMERS OF ALCOHOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 34B of chapter  
2 138 of the General Laws, as most recently amended is hereby  
3 futher amended by inserting in the first sentence after the words  
4 "section eight of chapter ninety," the following phrase: — or any  
5 military identification issued by an agency of the federal  
6 government, a valid driver's license from another state, or a  
7 foreign passport provided such identification contains the  
8 signature, date of birth and a photograph.

1 SECTION 2. Said first sentence of second paragraph is further  
2 amended by striking, from the phase "for proof of a person's  
3 identity" the word "a" and inserting in place thereof the word  
4 "such".
