## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A LIMITED MILITARY RETIREE EXEMPTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 21 of Chapter 233 of the Acts of 1983, is  
3 hereby further amended by adding after paragraph (b), the  
4 following: —

5 (c) notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the first  
6 three thousand dollars of retirement pay for all retired members  
7 of the Armed Forces of the United States, who have attained the  
8 age of sixty-five prior to the beginning of the taxable year, shall  
9 be exempt from taxation.
