AN ACT PROVIDING RELIEF TO CERTAIN PUBLIC CHARITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 12 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 from the first sentence of the second paragraph of section 8F the  
3 phrase "one hundred thousand dollars" and by inserting in place  
4 thereof the following: — "four hundred thousand dollars".
