By Mr. Mandile of Waltham, petition of Anthony M. Mandile relative to further regulating the expenditures of public monies by school departments. Education, Arts and Humanities.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE EXPENDITURES OF PUBLIC MONIES BY SCHOOL DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33B of chapter 44 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the word "department", in line 3, the first time it
4 appears, the following: —, including the school department.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 34, as appearing in the 1984 Offi-
3 cial Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 Section 34. Every city and town shall annually provide an
6 amount of money sufficient for the support of the public schools
7 as required by this chapter, provided however, that no city or town
8 shall be required to provide more money for the support of the
9 public schools than is appropriated by vote of the legislative body
10 of the city or town.
