AN ACT REQUIRING APPLICANTS FOR STATE EMPLOYMENT TO COMPLY WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 60 the following section: —
- 3 Section 60A. Every applicant for employment in any capacity
- 4 by the commonwealth shall verify, if applicable, his compliance
- 5 with the federal Military Selective Service Act in effect on July
- 6 first, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
