The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT REGULATING THE RETIREMENT OF TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of section 5 chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by Chapter 630 of the Acts of 1982,
3 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following
4 new subsection:

5 (n) Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter to the
6 contrary, any member-in-service who is employed by a School
7 Committee of a city, town, regional school district or independent
8 vocational school may elect to retire for superannuation after the
9 completion of thirty (30) years of creditable service provided that
10 said member has attained the age of fifty-five. The normal yearly
11 amount of the retirement allowance for any such member shall
12 be based upon the average annual rate of regular compensation
13 received by such member during any period of three (3)
14 consecutive years of creditable service for which such rate of
15 compensation was the highest, or on the average annual rate of
16 regular compensation received by such member during the period
17 or periods, whether consecutive or not, constituting his last three
18 (3) years of creditable service preceding retirement, whichever is
19 greater, and shall be computed by multiplying two and one-half
20 percent by the number of years of creditable service and by the
21 amount of the average annual rate of regular compensation as set
22 forth above and shall not exceed the limitations of paragraph (c)
23 of subdivision (2) of this section.
