AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAMS AT THE JAILS OF THE COUNTIES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The division of capital planning and operations, being duly  
2 authorized under the provisions of Chapter 785 of the Acts of 1985  
3 to expend ten million dollars for improvements to lockup facili-  
4 ties of the cities and towns of the commonwealth, is hereby  
5 authorized to expend the sum of five hundred thousand dollars,  
6 (\$500,000) of that sum, to study the feasibility of implementing  
7 the provisions of section thirty-six B of chapter forty of the  
8 General Laws, in the jails of the several counties of the Common-  
9 wealth of Massachusetts.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the year one thousand and no. of the year

- 1 The Division of Capital Planning and Operations, being duly authorized under the provisions of Chapter 233B of the Acts of 1962
- 2 to expand the public utility industry, consistent with the public interest of the state and under the responsibility of the Commission
- 3 authorized to expend the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) of that sum to study the feasibility of establishing
- 4 the provisions of section thirty-six B of chapter four of the General Laws, in the fall of the several sessions of the Legislature
