AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE PRICING PRACTICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 93B of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end
- 3 thereof the following subsections: —
- 4 (d) to offer for sale a new motor vehicle which does not display
- 5 the manufacturer's price sticker on a side window.
- 6 (e) to offer for sale a new motor vehicle which does not include
- 7 a full, written explanation of any dealer-imposed costs included
- 8 as part of the purchase price which are in addition to those
- 9 specified in the manufacturer's price sticker. Such explanation
- 10 shall be in bold type and be affixed to the window to which the
- 11 manufacturer's price is affixed, but shall not be attached in any
- 12 way to said sticker.
