RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF A STATE OSHA PLAN.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission is hereby established for
2 the purpose of examining the feasibility of implementing a plan
3 for an occupational safety and health administration within the
4 commonwealth. Said commission shall consist of three members
5 of the Senate, one of whom shall be the Senate chairman of the
6 joint committee on commerce and labor, five members of the
7 House of Representatives, one of whom shall be the House
8 chairman of the committee on commerce and labor, and seven
9 members to be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall
10 be the commissioner of the department of labor and industries,
11 one of whom shall be the commissioner of the department of
12 public health, one of whom shall be a representative of the
13 Massachusetts Coalition of Occupational Safety and Health, one
14 of whom shall be a representative of the Associated Industries of
15 Massachusetts, one of whom shall be a representative of the
16 Massachusetts AFL-CIO State Labor Council, one of whom shall
17 be a representative of business interests and one of whom shall
18 be a representative of worker-safety issues.

19 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
20 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
21 together with drafts of legislation to carry its recommendations
22 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the House of
23 Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in December
24 nineteen hundred and ninety. The report shall include evaluations

25 of the effectiveness of the health and safety, as well as the
26 operations of each department in administering the provisions of
27 the law.

Section 1001. The Life Commission of Statistics shall be a body
constituted by the Governor and the Senate.

1. The purpose of the Life Commission of Statistics shall be to

13. of whom shall be a representative of the Agricultural Industries
14. department, one of whom shall be a representative of the
15. department of the Department of Education, and of whom shall
16. be a representative of business interests and of whom shall
17. be a representative of public interest.
18. The commission shall report to the General Assembly the results
19. of its investigation and study and its recommendations. It may
20. together with other of its members or carry on investigations
21. and other matters with the staff of the House of
22. Representatives or in relation to the staff of the Department
23. of Health and Safety. The report shall include a statement
