AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN PERMITS FOR THE TAKING OF LOBSTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 38B of chapter 130 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "family", in line 61, the words: — or to any person  
4 experienced and qualified to enter the coastal lobster fishery. The  
5 approval for said transfer shall not be withheld by the director  
6 except for cause shown.
