AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF SUPERSONIC TRANSPORT
CATEGORY AIRCRAFT (SST) FROM STATE OWNED AIRPORTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The operation of all Supersonic Transport Category Aircraft
- 2 (SST) shall be prohibited from airports owned by the Common-
- 3 wealth, including those of the Massachusetts Port Authority.
