AN ACT ESTABLISHING MINIMUM STANDARDS OF FITNESS AND HABITABILITY FOR ROOMING AND LODGING HOUSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 25 the following section: —
- 3 Section 25A. The commissioner of the department of public
- 4 health shall establish and enforce a health code providing for
- 5 minimum standards of fitness and habitability for lodging houses
- 6 or other premises occupied under the provisions of this chapter.
