

By Mr. Serra of Boston, petition of Emanuel G. Serra for legislation to provide for the appointment of three members of the House and one member of the Senate to the Board of Directors of the Water Resources Authority. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THREE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE AND ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE BE ADDED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS WATER RESOURCES AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 372 of the General Laws
2 Acts of 1984 is hereby amended by striking after the word "of"
3 in line 13 and before the word "members" in line fourteen the word
4 "eleven" and inserting in place thereof the word "fifteen".

1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of Chapter 372 of the General Laws
2 Acts of 1984 is hereby amended by adding after the word "major"
3 in Line 34 the following: —
4 three members of the Board of Directors shall be appointed by
5 the Speaker of the House from the House of Representatives of
6 Massachusetts, and one member of the Board of Directors to be
7 appointed by the Senate President from the Senate. These
8 members of the House and Senate should represent communities
9 directly impacted by the sewer system and the waterworks system
10 of the Authority. Their term shall be one year and they shall serve
11 until their successor is appointed and qualified and each appointed
12 member shall be eligible for reappointment provided he or she
13 is still an elected representative to the House and Senate from
14 the aforementioned impacted areas.
