### AN ACT REGULATING PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 107 of chapter 697 of the acts and resolves of 1987 is
- 2 hereby amended by striking the phrase "provided, however, that
- 3 the regular compensation of such member shall include any
- 4 regular compensation received by such member after having made
- 5 such election." and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 6 "provided, however, that the regular compensation of such
- 7 member shall include any regular compensation received by such
- 8 member after having made such election, and shall include service
- 9 credit for the years of service accrued beyond age seventy."
