## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES CONFORM TO CERTAIN RATES OF WAGES RELATIVE TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 121B, section 26 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1988 Official Edition of the Massachusetts General Laws, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence of paragraph  
4 (m) and inserting in place thereof the following new sentence: —  
5 A local housing authority may create, designate or approve  
6 agencies or instrumentalities to provide such housing and do all  
7 other things necessary or desirable to secure financial or other  
8 forms of assistance from the federal government including the  
9 exemption from federal income taxation of interest on bonds or  
10 notes of such housing authority issued with respect to such  
11 housing, provided, any work performed with respect to such  
12 housing be in conformance to the rates of wages as provided for  
13 in chapter 149, section 26 of the General Laws.
