By Mr. Jakubowicz of Pittsfield, petition of Robert F. Jakubowicz and another that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be directed to issue identification cards to certain elderly persons. Public Safety.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO SENIOR CITIZENS NOT POSSESSING MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8E of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the
3 end thereof the following paragraph: —

4 Any person sixty-five years of age and older and not possessing
5 such a license, may make application as aforesaid and said
6 registrar shall issue such identification card upon payment of the
7 fee as prescribed by this section.
