### AN ACT CLARIFYING CERTAIN LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Amend Section 120D of Chapter 266 of the  
2 General Laws by deleting the words "other than during snow  
3 removal operations" from sub-section (1).

1 SECTION 2. Amend Section 120D of Chapter 266 of the  
2 General Laws by changing the reference in sub-section (1) from  
3 C. 159B, 6C to C. 159B, Section 6B.

1 SECTION 3. Amend Section 120D of Chapter 266 of the  
2 General Laws by deleting from sub-section (2) the words "twenty  
3 dollars per day or any portion thereof, with a minimum charge  
4 of ten dollars" and substituting therefor the words: "not more than  
5 the maximum storage charge allowed under the provisions of  
6 Section 6B of Chapter 159B of the General Laws, as amended  
7 from time to time".
