### AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPULSORY LIABILITY OF DRIVERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Be it enacted that licensed drivers involved in traffic accidents
- 2 shall not, without a review by the insurer, be found at fault solely
- 3 because the driver was making a left hand turn across traffic.
- 4 Neither shall a surcharge be levied on the individual's auto
- 5 insurance without such review.

The following is a list of the names of the members of the House of Representatives for the year 1911. The names are listed in alphabetical order by district.

# HOUSE

In the House of Representatives, the members are elected by the people of each State. The members of the House are elected for a term of two years.

## The Government of the United States

The Government of the United States is a federal republic. The President is the head of the executive branch. The Congress is the legislative branch, consisting of the House of Representatives and the Senate. The Supreme Court is the head of the judicial branch.

The President is elected by the people for a term of four years. The President has the power to sign laws and to appoint and remove judges and other officials.

The House of Representatives is elected by the people of each State. The number of representatives from each State is based on the population of that State. The House has the power to initiate and pass laws, to impeach and remove the President, and to control the federal budget.
