AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a pilot program with-
2 in the Department of Public Health to provide hepatitis B vac-
3 cine to such emergency medical technicians, ambulance operators
4 and ambulance attendants currently employed in the Common-
5 wealth of Massachusetts. Said pilot program shall be established
6 in areas of high infection from hepatitis B as the department shall
7 determine.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of section one of this act, there
2 is hereby appropriated the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand
3 dollars.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE

Enacted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of New York, in Regular Session, on the 15th day of February, 1911.

SECTION 1.
