AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOSPITAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 64 of Chapter 6A, as inserted by Section 1B of Chapter
- 2 372 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 third sentence of the second paragraph the following sentence: —
- 4 Such regulations shall contain reporting requirements governing
- 5 mandatory disclosure of financial data, in such form as the
- 6 commission shall determine, concerning every organization with
- 7 which an acute hospital is affiliated, including but not limited to
- 8 related or affiliated corporations, partnerships, holding
- 9 companies, and/or subsidiaries.

- 6 commission shall determine, consistent with organization with
- 7 which an acute hospital is affiliated, including but not limited to
- 8 related or affiliated departments, laboratories, building
- 9 equipment and/or subsidiaries.
