AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REHABILITATION OF PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26, clause (j) of Chapter one hundred twenty-one B of
2 the General Laws as most recently amended by Section twenty-
3 seven of Chapter eight hundred-eight of the Acts of 1981 is hereby
4 amended by striking the final proviso of clause (j) and adding the
5 following: "and provided, further, that notwithstanding the pro-
6 visions of any other law, where the funding for such project or
7 any similar state or federally funded undertaking with respect to
8 low-rent housing exceeds fifteen million dollars and the number
9 of households living on the original site when funds are or were
10 committed exceeds two hundred, the award of construction,
11 reconstruction, installation, demolition, maintenance, alteration,
12 remodeling or repair contracts shall be governed by the provisions
13 of section thirty-nine M of chapter thirty, and shall include a
14 requirement for certification of ability to furnish labor that can
15 work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or
16 to be employed in the work, and shall not be subject to the pro-
17 visions of sections forty-four A to forty-four H, inclusive, of chap-
18 ter one hundred and forty-nine."
