AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE UPGRADING OF VOTING MACHINES, BALLOT BOXES AND COUNTING APPARATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding after the last sentence contained therein the
3 following: —

4 The state secretary shall contribute annually to cities and towns
5 a sum of money equal to \$.10 (ten cents) per registered voter who
6 is a resident of that city or town for the purposes of upgrading
7 the voting machines, ballot boxes and counting apparatus in the
8 custody and care of that city or town.
