AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE BUREAU OF STATE OFFICE BUILDINGS TO THE OFFICE OF THE SERGEANT AT ARMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Sergeant at Arms shall have charge of the  
2 care and operation of the State House, the John W. McCormack  
3 State Office Building, the Leverett Saltonstall State Office  
4 Building, the Springfield and Pittsfield State Office Buildings, the  
5 Charles F. Hurley Building, the Erich Lindemann Building, the  
6 building at 100 Nashua Street in the City of Boston and all State  
7 parking areas related thereto.

1 SECTION 2. All Permanent Civil Service personnel of the  
2 Bureau of State Office Buildings are hereby transferred to the  
3 Sergeant at Arms office without loss of Civil Service rights.
