AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR MANDATED POLLUTION CONTROL DEVICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (s) of section six of chapter 64H of  
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is  
3 hereby amended by inserting in line 298 after the words "or  
4 function;" the following words: — "or used as an adjunct or  
5 attachment to such machinery already exempt under this section  
6 which adjunct or attachment is required under federal or state law,  
7 regulation or rule to safeguard the health and safety of workers,  
8 the public or the environment in general;"

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect on  
2 January first, nineteen hundred and ninety.
