AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETURNING A PORTION OF THE SALES TAX REVENUE TO THE CITY OR TOWN FROM WHICH IT WAS GENERATED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by deleting the second sentence and inserting in place  
3 thereof a new second sentence which reads as follows: The excise  
4 tax shall be paid by the vendor to the commissioner at the time  
5 provided for filing the return required by section sixteen of chapter  
6 sixty-two C; provided further that said commissioner shall return  
7 20% of said excise tax to the city or town in which it was generated.
