

HOUSE No. 4116

By Mrs. Gray of Framingham, petition of Barbara E. Gray for legislation to provide for the revocation of firearms licenses of convicted felons by the Commissioner of Public Safety. Public Safety.

AN ACT TO REQUIRE NOTIFICATION TO THE POLICE CHIEF OF THE CITY OR TOWN WHEREIN RESIDES A PERSON CONVICTED OF A FELONY WHO HOLDS A LICENSE TO CARRY A FIREARM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 140 Section 131 as appearing in the 1988
- 2 Official Edition of the Massachusetts General Laws is amended
- 3 by adding after line 106, the following:
- 4 The Attorney General of Massachusetts must notify in writing
- 5 the Commissioner of Public Safety of all convicted felons.

- 1 SECTION 2. The Commissioner of Public Safety must revoke
- 2 the license of any felon who holds a firearm license and forward
- 3 written notice to the Chief of Police or other local licensing
- 4 authority providing notice of and causation for such revocation.
