The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOLDING WHOLESALER AND RETAILER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 18 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 520 of the Acts of 1973, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the last sentence of the fourth paragraph
4 and inserting in its place the following: —

5 No person who holds a license under this section shall hold or
6 be granted a license under Section 12 or Section 15. A person shall
7 be deemed to hold a license under this section and Section 12 or
8 Section 15 if such person or any member of his immediate family
9 holds a license under each of said sections. As used in this section
10 the words "immediate family" shall include the licensee and his
11 spouse and their parents, children, brothers and sisters, and their
12 spouses. Violations of the provisions of this section shall be cause
13 for the revocation of all licenses held by the licensee or his
14 immediate family.

15 In the case of a corporate license any person or his immediate
16 family who owns more than ten percent of the stock of such
17 corporation be deemed to be the licensee for the purposes of this
18 section.
