AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPEAL FROM ADMINISTRATORS REVIEW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 24 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the last sentence of said Section 24 and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following new sentence: — In deciding an  
4 appeal pursuant to this section relative to training and experience,  
5 the applicant shall be allowed seventeen days after the date of  
6 mailing of the marks, to appeal and receive credit for training and  
7 experience that was not filed by the applicant at the time of the  
8 examination.
