RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO COST EFFECTIVENESS AND CONTRACTUAL COMPLIANCE OF CERTAIN HUMAN SERVICE VENDOR CONTRACTS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three mem-
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives,
3 the commissioner of correction or his designee, the chairman of
4 the youth service board or his designee, the commissioner of
5 education or his designee, the commissioner of mental health or
6 his designee, the commissioner of public health or his designee,
7 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby
8 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study
9 relative to the cost effectiveness and contractual compliance of
10 vendor contracts with the departments of education, correction,
11 mental health, public health and the youth service board to
12 operate community based facilities and facilities providing
13 education and need for children with special needs.
